sum of sixteen pounds two shillings & six pence current money of Virginia paid to me in hand
before the sealing & delivering hereof by Henry Adams in the said County aforesaid in the
Colony of Virginia the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge & myself therewith fully satisfied
& contented & thereof & of every part & parcel thereof do acquit & discharge the said Henry Adams
his heirs & assigns forever by these presents I have given granted & bargained sold alienated given
& confirmed by these presents to do freely fully & absolutely give grant bargain sellations & confirmments
to the said Henry Adams his heirs & assigns forever one certain tract of land situated lying &
being in the County of Southampton on the North side of the Three Creeks & bounded as followeth
to wit Beginning at a poplar on the south side of plowman swamp thence Ten Degrees west one
hundred & three poles to a red oak thence North eighty Degrees west one hundred & sixty poles to a
pinetree North Ten Degrees east fifty five poles to a gum by the side of a small branch then
down the various courses of the run of the said Branch to plowman swamp as aforesaid to down
the various courses of the run of the said swamp to the beginning to have & to hold the said
granted & bargained premises with all the appurtenances privileges & signs forever to his
