All Christian people to whom these presents shall come greeting know ye that I Timothy Thorp of Southampton County in the province of Virginia for & in consideration of the sum of Seventeen pounds two Shillings & Sixpence current money of Virginia paid to me in hand before the En sealing & Delivering here of by Henry Adams in the said County aforesaid in the Colony of Virginia the Receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge & myself there with fully satisfied & contented & thereof of every part & parcel thereof do acquit & Discharge the said Henry Adams his heirs heirs & Admors forever by these presents Have given granted & bargained sold Alienated conveyed & confirmed & by these presents do freely fully & absolutely give grant bargain sell Alienate & confirm unto the said Henry Adams his heirs & assigns forever one certain Tract & parcel of Land situate Lying & being in the County of Southampton on the North side of the Three Creeks & bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a poplar on the south side of Plowman swamp thence Ten Degrees west one Hundred & three poles to a Red Oak thence North eighty Degrees west one Hundred & Sixty poles to a pine then North Ten Degrees east - fifty five poles to a Gum by the side of a small branch then Down the various courses of the run of the said branch to Plowman swamp as aforesaid & Down the various courses of the run of the said swamp to the beginning To have & to hold the said granted & bargained premises with all the the Appurtenances privileges & assigns forever to his
