 heirs & assigns that he will warrant & forever Defend against all person or persons what so ever the

 Sixty Between David Burr of Southampton County in Virginia of the one part & Jesse Council of Jole-
 of right County of the other part Witnesseth that the said David Burr for & in consideration of the sum
 of Ten pounds current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Jesse Council at or before the
 the Insealing & Delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said David Burr doth hereby acknow-
 ledge he the said Burr hath granted bargained & sold aliened Inseffed & confirmed & by these presents
 Doth Grant bargain sell alien Inseff & confirm unto the said Jesse Council his heirs & assigns forever
 a certain Tract or parcel of Land containing one Hundred Acres more or less situate lying & being in
 Southampton County being part of Patent granted to the said David Burr by William Lynde Esqr
 Lieut Governor & Commander in Chief of the Colony of Virginia bearing Date the 2nd Day of July one
 Thousand seven Hundred & forty Six also part of another Patent granted to the said David Burr by
 Lewis Burwell Esqr President & Commander in Chief of the aforesaid Colony bearing Date the 10th Day of
 September one Thousand seven Hundred & fifty one & bounded as followeth Beginning at a gum
