 delivered witnesseth that the said Jordan Thomas for & in consideration of the sum of Thirty pounds current money
 of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said William Willeford the receipt whereof the said Jordan
 Thomas doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained & sold Alliened In feoff & confirmed in
 by these presents doth grant bargain & sell Alvin In feoff & confirmed unto the said William Willeford
 his heirs & assigns forever a certain Tract or parcel of Land lying & being on the South side of the Main
 Black Water swamp in the County of Southampton containing by Estimation one Hundred Acres or
 some more or less which said Land was mortgaged to the said Jordan Thomas by Robert
 Lancaster & Bounded according to the Antient known & Reputed Bounds thereof with all the
 Estate Right Title Interest property Claim & Demand what soever of him the said Jordan
 Thomas of in to the same or any part or parcel thereof to have & to hold the said one Hundred
 Acres of Land abovementioned & every part & parcel thereof unto the said William Willeford & to his heirs
 & assigns to the only proper use & behoof of the said William Willeford his heirs & assigns forever
 & the said Jordan Thomas for himself & his heirs the said one Hundred Acres of Land & every
 part & parcel thereof against them & his heirs & against all every person or persons what
 soever unto the said William Willeford his heirs & assigns shall & will warrant & forever defend
 by these presents for Witness whereof the said Jordan Thomas hath hereunto set his hand
 and Affixed his seal the day & year above Written
