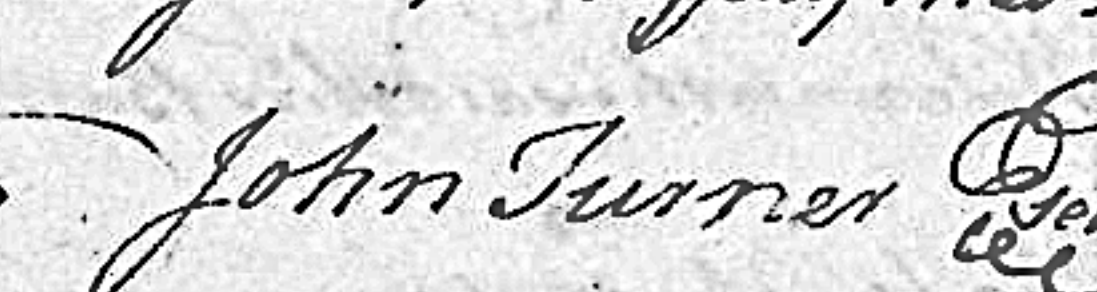

Infeoffed & confirmed & by these presents doth give grant bargain sell Alien. Infeoff & confirm unto the said Thomas Barnes all his Intres. claim. Right & Demand unto one certain tract or parcel of Land containing Two hundred & eighty seven acres of Land more or less & bounded as followeth begining at a gum in fork of the line Branch then by a line of marked trees to a black oak. Then by a line of marked trees to a pine the dividing line then by a line of marked trees to a black oak a line of William Proves Land then by proper lines to a black oak a line of Henry Proves Land a corner then by proper lines to a white oak in the side of the line Branch as aforesaid then down the various courses of the run of the said Branch to a swamp then up the said swamp to a poplar joining William Proves Land then along the dividing between Henry Proves & William Proves to a white oak then by a line of marked trees a
