This Indenture made this 6th day of November in the Thirtieth year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord George the second now King of Great Britain France & Ireland & so forth in the year of our Lord Christ one Thousand seven Hundred & fifty nine between George Jordan & Patience his wife of the County of Southampton in the province of North Carolina of the one part & Howell Hinget of the parish of Northway in the County of Southampton of the other part Whereas Thomas Warren late of the parish of Northway in the County of Isle of Wight now Southampton was in his Lifetime at the time of his death seized & possessed of one certain Tract or parcel of Land containing one hundred & eighty Acres or thereabouts lying & being in the County of Southampton aforesaid & being seized died having first made his Last Will & Testament in writing whereby he devised the said Land to his wife Sarah during her natural Life & after her decease to his son Thomas & his heirs forever which said son Thomas is since dead without issue whereby the fee simple inheritance of the said Land after the death of the said Sarah his Widow & he lieth descended & came to the four daughters & heirs of the said Thomas Warren And Whereas the said Patience party hereto is one of the said Daughters & heirs of the said Thomas & hath intermarried with the said George Jordan & is intitled to one fourth part of the Reversion & inheritance of the said undivided Tract or parcel of Land containing in the whole one hundred & eighty Acres or thereabouts as aforesaid Now this Indenture therefore Witnesseth that the said George Jordan and
