I know all men by these presents that I Thomas Turner Sen of the County of Isle of Wight in Virginia for divers good causes & considerations but more especially for the good will & Affection I bear to my loving son Henry Turner in the same County & in Virginia whereunto moving having giving & granted by these presents to give grant & confirm unto the said Henry Turner one certain Tract or parcel of Land situate lying & being in Southampton County in the Fork of black Creek & black water & bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at the mouth of black Creek running up black water to the mouth of a branch to a white oak a corner Tree of Joshua Whitney's Land then along Whitney's line to a pine a corner Tree then down a straight line to black Creek to a maple a corner Tree then down the various courses of the Creek to the first Station containing by Estimation one Hundred & fifty Acres be the same more or less All and singular my Right & Title to satisfy & confirming unto my son Henry Turner to him & his heirs forever the said Tract or parcel of Land to his proper use & behoof Whatsoever of me the said Thomas Turner unto the said Henry Turner his heirs & assigns from hence forth & there on of proper use & Title thereof & there with to do order & Dispose of his or their own wills and pleasures free and peaceably and Quietly without any manner of Let Trouble or Denial of me the said Thomas Turner or any other person or persons Whatsoever of all rights premises the said Thomas Turner have put the said Henry Turner in full and peaceable possession by Virtue hereof In Witness whereof the said Thomas Turner have hereto set my hand and seal this 8th day May 1760.
