This Indenture made the 30 day of May in the year of our Lord one Thousand seven hundred & sixty between Hardy Pope of the County of Southampton of the one part & Robert Carr of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Hardy Pope for & in consideration of the sum of Six pounds eleven shillings & eight pence current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Robert Carr before the sealing & Delivering hereof Receipt whereof the said Hardy Pope doth hereby acknowledge Hath granted Bargained & sold & Doth by these presents grant Bargain & sell unto the said Robert Carr his heirs or assigns a certain Tract or parcel of Land lying in the County of Southampton on the north side of the main black water swamp containing one Hundred Acres more or less the said Land beginning in the Little parsonage to a poplar & running bars line to the long branch & up the long branch to Harris's line & along Harris's line to the first Statibru which the said Land the said Hardy Pope hath for ever Bargained & sold & Delivered to the said Robert Carr that he hath in himself a good right & absolute power to make sale of the said Land and doth hereby warrant the sale thereof said Land to the said Robert Carr for him self his heirs or assigns or any other person or persons saying any right Title or claim or Interest that the said Robert Carr his heirs or assigns shall & may from time to time & at all times use occupy & enjoy the said Land without Interrupting of any person or persons what soever In Witness whereof the said Hardy Pope hath hereunto set his hand and seal the day and year above Written.

This Indenture made this 24 day of May in the year of our Lord God one Thousand seven hundred & sixty between Richard Taylor Senr of the County of Southampton of the one part & Elias Fort of the County of said of the other part Witnesseth that the said Richard Taylor for & in consideration of the sum of five pounds current money to him in hand paid at & before the sealing & Delivery of these presents by the said Elias Fort the Receipt whereof he doth acknowledge & acquit & Discharge him his heirs, Executors, Administrators & assigns firmly by these presents Hath given granted alienated Bargained & sold Transferred Infeoffed & confirmed & by these presents Doth fully absolutely give grant bargain sell & make over assigns & confirm unto the said Elias Fort his heirs & assigns for ever one certain Tract or parcel of Land containing one Hundred & ninety five Acres more or less bounded by a marked line (to wit) Beginning at a white oak on the South West side of Cochs swamp thence S. West one Hundred & seven poles a pine the south twenty degrees East thirty six poles to a light wooden post James Davin's line thence by S. West one Hundred forty poles to a Red Oak thence East by the side of Cochs Swamp as fore said & up the various courses of the Run of the said swamp to the Beginning also seven by Acres more the courses as now Beginning at a white oak by the side of Cochs swamp a corner of the said Tayors other Land thence by one old line S. West one Hundred & ten poles to a pine thence South four Degrees west thirty four poles to a

pine in Davin's Marsh thence swamp as fore said Hole padden to Chief for Dingo to John Hobbs Juridictions & Advantages in all the Richd Taylor & into the all singular with all & doth his heirs & assigns for ever & all persons who do & heretofore making or Fort his heirs & assigns in presence of William & William & Edward D.
