

Confirm unto the said Benjⁿ Lewis & his heirs & assigns forever all the said Zebulon Lewis his tractor parcel
of Land situate lying & being in the parish of Nottoway in the County of Southampton aforesaid near the
Three Creeks & devised to him by the last Will & Testament of his Father Zebulon Lewis deceased now in the tenure
