This Indenture made and entered into this 26th day of November 1825 between Benjamin Appelwhite of the County of Southampton of the first part John Mason of the said County of the second part and Thomas Appelwhite and Seth Nicholson of the said County of the third part Whereas the said Thomas and Seth are willing to be bound and assist the said Benjamin by becoming bound as his security in a bond or bonds hereafter to be given to one or more persons for a good sum of money not exceeding two thousand four hundred dollars and whereas it is the intention & desire of the said Benjamin by means of the property herein after conveyed to provide for the entire satisfaction & payment of them his said securities. Now this indenture witnesses that the said Benjamin Appelwhite for and in consideration of the premises as well as of the sum of One dollar to him in hand paid by the said John Mason before the sealing of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and conveyed and by these presents he doth give grant sell and transfer unto him the said Thomas a certain tract or parcel of Land situate in the said County and lying on the stream called the Blue Creek containing by recent survey four hundred & eighty six and to the same more or less it being the same tract of land lately purchased by the said Benjamin of his Brother Henry Appelwhite. To have and to hold the said tract of Land with all its appurtenances unto him the said Thomas his heirs and assigns in fee simple forever upon trust nevertheless that the said Thomas and his assigns shall permit the said Benjamin Appelwhite to remain in quiet possession of the said tract of Land and enjoy the same profits and emoluments arising therefrom as he may think proper until the said Benjamin Appelwhite and his securities aforesaid shall have become liable to an action or actions in any of the said Bonds above mentioned by reason of the said Benjamin failing to pay off any or all of the said sums of money & which they may be bound as aforesaid then the said John Mason his heirs or his assigns shall take possession of the said tract of Land & after duly advertising the time and place for thirty days at least shall sell the premises herein conveyed upon such terms as the said parties of the third part shall designate and if the proceeds of such sale shall proceed to discharge them debts which shall remain unsatisfied for the payment whereof the said Thomas Appelwhite and Seth Nicholson shall be bound as securities as aforesaid after paying the expenses of this trust and the said Benjamin for himself his heirs doth. Covenant with the said John Mason & the said parties of the third part that he will secure a good & perfect title to the
