This Indenture made this 28th day of February 1826 in the year of our Lord 1826 Between Samuel Butler and John Foster and Sally his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and John Foster and Sally his wife of Brunswick County and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Foster and Sally his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars Cash and money of Virginia to him in hand paid by Lewis Harris and Howell Blair of the receipt whereof the said John Foster and Sally his wife do the hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold aliened and confirmed and by their presents do grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said Lewis Harris and Howell Blair their heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land containing by Estimation two hundred & forty eight acres be the same more or less lying and being in the County of Southampton Parish of Saint Luke bounded as follows beginning at a Elm corner of Richard Taylors land by the road of Cooks Swamp thence by the said Taylors land to a white oak corner of Charles land thence along the said Charles land to a live oak corner of Blake land in the pond branch thence along Blake land to a corner of John Parsons land to the live swamp branch thence along Parsons land to a corner of said Parsons land to a red oak in Parsons land and thence by a line of marked trees to a pine in the head of swamp branch and thence along said branch to Cooks Swamp and then up the run of the said Swamp to the beginning with all wood under swamp marshes for ground buildings hereditaments and Commodities whatsoever And the reversion and remainders unto Lewis Harris and Howell Blair and every part thereof also the Estate right title claim interest and demand whatsoever of the said John Foster and Sally his wife their heirs Executors & of and to the same said Harris and Howell Blair and every part thereof with the appurtenances unto the said Lewis Harris and Howell Blair their heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said Lewis Harris and Howell Blair their heirs and assigns forever And the said John Foster and Sally his wife for themselves their heirs Executors & of the said said Harris and Howell Blair and every part thereof against me and my heirs & of shall & will warrant & forever defend from myself my Executors & of from all & every person or persons whatsoever In witness whereof the said John Foster and Sally his wife have hereunto set their hand & seals the day & year above written
