Taughman his wife for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred & forty five dollars & twenty five Cents good and lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Nathaniel Francis on or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they the said John T. Taughman and Mary T. Taughman his wife doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained sold & aliened & confirmed unto the said Nathaniel Francis and to his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land containing One hundred and thirty seven acres be the same more or less bounded as follows To wit by the land formerly Thomas Foster dec'd then by the land belonging to Edmund Turner Orphans dec'd then by the land belonging to Samuel Drury and then by the land belonging to Sally Francis To have and to hold the said One hundred and thirty seven acres of Land with all and singular the appurtenances thereto unto the said Nathaniel Francis to his heirs and assigns forever and the said John T. Taughman and Mary T. Taughman his wife doth for them even and heirs forever Covenant and agree with the said Nathaniel Francis his heirs and assigns that the said John T. Taughman and Mary T. Taughman his wife their heirs Executors and assigns shall and lawfully warrant and forever defend the above mentioned Land and premises unto the said Nathaniel Francis to him and his heirs forever against the Claims of any person or Persons.
