 willing to secure to the use and benefit of the said Church and Congregation more extensive lands and tracts
 agreed and doth by these presents agree to and with the said Jacob Darden for and on behalf of the
 Baptist Church aforesaid and their successors that instead of the boundaries mentioned and designated by
 the deed aforesaid the following shall be and is by these presents declared and established as the true &
 permanent boundaries of the lot of land attached to the meeting house aforesaid for the use of the
 Church and Congregation aforesaid to wit Beginning at a small pine standing on a Easterly direction
 from the meeting house running thence N 80 E 12 chains or links to a red oak thence 23 30 E 7 chains
 to the Road thence N 82 W 4 chains along the centre of the road thence N 57 W 11 chains 4 3
 links to a point near the south side of the road thence by a straight line to the beginning containing
 three acres two rods more or less But it is to be understood that the one acre at present belonging
 to the said Church by the deed from Holland Darden above mentioned is included in the above bounds
 and is therefore to be deducted leaving two acres two rods and thirty nine poles to be conveyed by these
 presents Now therefore for and consideration of the sum of sixteen dollars and eleven Cents to him the said Jesse Parker on
 hand paid by the said Jacob Darden at and before the creating and delivery of these presents
 the said Jesse Parker for himself his heirs Executors and administrators hath granted bargained
 sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien & confirm to
 him the said Jacob Darden for the use and benefit of the Baptist Church aforesaid. To
 his heirs and assigns forever the aforesaid 2 acres 2 rods 29 poles of Land included in the boundaries
 aforesaid To have and to hold the said lot or piece of Land to and for the use and benefit of the said
 its appurtenances profits and emoluments to him the said Jacob Darden his heirs & assigns
 forever Upon trust for the use and benefit of the Baptist Church aforesaid and the Congre-
 gation from time to time may meet and assemble there for the purpose of Divine worship
 howsoever forth and forward and he the said Jesse Parker for himself his heirs Executors and admin-
 doth and will by these presents warrant and defend the lot or piece of Land with its appurtenances
 aforesaid against the lawful claim or demand of all and every person whatsoever to him the said
 Jacob Darden for the purpose herein before mentioned and to his heirs and assigns forever the
 witness whereof they the said Jesse Parker and Jacob Darden have hereunto set their hands &

 thence up the dividing line between Peter S Pierce and John Pond thence up to the
 beginning by Petersburg road together with all the singular and appurtenances whatsoever
