Drake and Mary W. Drake for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and fifteen dollars to them in hand paid by the said John Drake before the said day and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge and thereof and thus from do acquit and discharge the said John Drake and thereafter have bargained sold aliened conveyed and by these presents do bargain sell alien convey and confirm unto the said John Drake his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton State of Virginia being a part of the land come by Jeremiah Drake decd. Containing by late survey sixty four acres and being bounded as follows on the west by the land of Edward Drake on the East by Benjamin Whitfield on the South by John B. Drake decd land on the north by the land of a Martha Drake which said land being well known by the common boundaries with all and every the Easements Appurtenances and appurtenances unto the said John Drake his heirs and assigns forever the said Samuel Drake Nancy G. Drake and Mary W. Drake do make over and confirm unto the said John Drake his heirs and assigns forever So have and to hold the same unto the said John Drake his heirs and assigns forever and the said Samuel Drake Nancy G. Drake and Mary W. Drake defend the right title of the said land against themselves their heirs and assigns and all and every person or persons whomsoever claiming or that may lawfully claim the same or any part or parcel thereof unto the said John Drake his heirs and assigns forever Shall and will warrant and defend by these presents sealed with our seals dated the day of year above written

This Indenture made and entered into on this 10th day of March in the year of our Lord Christ 1826 Between Joel Williams of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Lewis Morrell of the same County and State of the other part witnesseth that the said Joel Williams for and in consideration of the sum of Eleven hundred dollars current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Lewis Morrell at or before the Enrolling and delivery of these presents the full receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold aliened conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto him the said Lewis Morrell and his heirs forever one certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Luke Containing by a late survey one hundred & eighty acres be the same more or less it being lots No. 1 & 2 in the division of the land of Nathan Williams decd which were allotted to Miles Williams and said Joel Williams by the Commissioners who were appointed by the Court to divide the land of said Nathan Williams decd their further as will appear by their report on record or on the plot of said decedent's land No. 1 containing eighty acres more or less allotted to said Joel Williams Lot No. 3 allotted to Miles Williams containing one hundred acres more or less which said Lot or tract of land of one hundred acres be the said Joel Williams purchased of said Miles Williams and as will appear by their deed on record for the same and the Lots or

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
