Drake of the one part and John Drake of the other part all of the County of Southampton State of Virginia witnesseth that the said Samuel Drake Nancy G. Drake and Mary W. Drake for themselves and of the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars to them in hand paid by the said John Drake before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge and thereof and therfrom do accept And discharge the said John Drake and therupon have bargained sold & delivered and by these presents do bargain sell alien enfeoff and Confer unto the said John Drake his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton State of Virginia being a part of the land owned by Jerome Drake decd. Containing by late Survey forty four acres and being bounded as follows on the west by the land of Edwin Brink on the east by Benjamin Whitley on the south by Jeptha B. Drake said land on the north by the land of Martha Drake which said land being well known by the common boundaries with all and every the easements & profits of all manner & descriptions unto the said John Drake his heirs and assigns forever the said Samuel Drake Nancy G. Drake and Mary W. Drake do make over and Confer unto the said John Drake his heirs and assigns forever To have and to hold the same unto the said John Drake his heirs and assigns forever and the said Samuel Drake Nancy G. Drake and Mary W. Drake defend the right title of the said land against themselves their heirs and assigns and all and every person or persons whomsoever claiming or that may lawfully the same or any part or parcel thereof unto the said John Drake his heirs and assigns forever shall and will warrant and defend by these presents sealed with our seals dated the day of our above written

This Indenture made and entered into on this 10th day of March in the year of our Lord Christ 1826 Between Joel Williams of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Daniel Gaines & Caines of the same County and State of the other part witnesseth that the said Joel Williams for consideration of the sum of Seven hundred dollars current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Lewis Morell at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the full accept whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold alien enfeoffed & conferred and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien and Confer unto him the said Lewis Morell and his heirs forever one certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Luke containing by a late Survey one hundred & eighty acres to the same more or less being lots No. 1 & 3 in the division of the land of Nathan Williams deceased which were allotted to Miles Williams and said Joel Williams by the Commissioners who were appointed by the Court to divide the land of said Nathan Williams deceased their further as well appear by their report on record or on the plot of said deceased land 1827 Lot No. 1 & 3 containing eighty acres more or less allotted to said Joel Williams lot No. 3 allotted to Miles Williams containing one hundred acres more or less which said lot or tract of land of one hundred acres he the said Joel Williams purchased of said Miles Williams and left as well appear by their deed on record for the same and the lots or
