Barnes and Louisa his wife of the County of Northampton and State of North Carolina of the first part and Sally Everett of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the second part Witnesseth that the said Rollin W. Barnes and Louisa his wife for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred dollars to them in hand paid and also one negro Girl by the name of Sarah delivered and also the amount of the legacy given by the will of John Faircloth dec'd to his boy Peter Funckle the now to be paid by the said Sally Everett to the said Peter hath granted bargained sold aliened conveyed and Confirmed and by these presents do the grant bargain sell alien convey and Confirm unto the said Sally Everett her heirs & assigns one certain tract of land lying in the County of Southampton containing three hundred and Seventy five acres be the same more or less bounded by the lands of Richard Blank Jacob Barnes and Charles Bryant being the same tract of Land which was due by the said Sally Everett to John Faircloth
