Have granted given bargained and sold and by these presents do & each of them doth give bargain grant and sell unto the said Albridgepton Edward his heirs & assigns forever a certain tract of land purchased by said James Edward of the Estate of Henry Briggs does bounded by the down land of said estate and the lands of James Wells Samuel Henry and Amos Stephenson and containing by Estimation one hundred and ninety seven and a half acres together with the reversions and accretions remainder and remainders yearly and other profits and profits and every part and parcel thereof Except such as may accrue during the natural life time the said James Edward all of which so accruing are hereby saved and specially reserved unto the proper use of them the said James Edward and Martha his wife as well as all right to hold and possess said tract of land for and during said term To have and to hold the said tract of land with the tenements hereditaments and all and singular the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be given granted bargained and sold with every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights members appurtenances unto the said Albridgepton Edward his heirs and assigns forever In Witness whereof the said James Edward and Martha his wife have hereunto set their hand and affixed their seals the day and year above written
