Darden did on the 18th day of August 1823 execute a deed of trust to the said Simon Murfee for the benefit of Samuel Story on a certain tract of land containing Eighty four acres and bounded by the lands of Jesse Darden and others for the purpose of securing a debt due the said Story but the above debt being fully paid unto the said Story and the said Story satisfied thereon the said Story and Simon Murfee wish to release the said land to the said Jesse B. Darden his heirs and assigns forever from all claims or demands that we have on the said land or premises and we do for ourselves our heirs Executors and assigns release unto the said Jesse B.
