Vick his heirs and assigns the tract of land on which on which he the said Stade now resides situate in the County of Southampton and Estimated to contain seventy-five acres be the same more or less to have and to hold to him the said Vick his heirs and assigns forever upon trust nevertheless that if the said Miles Stade shall fail to secure and to pay him up from him the said Henry Penn by reason of his responsibility aforesaid he the said Vick shall at any time pay to the said Master the said sum of money and on demand he the said Stade shall fail to pay it to him then the said Vick to enter into possession of the said land and after advertising the time and place of sale for thirty days to the said Stade and at some publick place to sell the said parcel of land to the highest bidder or so much thereof as shall be necessary to refund the said debt and out of the proceeds pay to the said Henry Penn the said debt with any interest & costs thereon as well as the costs attending the execution of this indenture and if the said Stade shall fail to pay him by either paying the said debt himself or returning to the said Penn whatever he may have paid as aforesaid then this Indenture to be void. Briggs and Sally his wife of the one part and Henry Penn of the other part all parties of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia witnesseth that the said William H. Briggs and Sally his wife for an consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars to him in hand paid receipt & fully acknowledged have bargained sold & by these presents do absolutely bargain sell and confirm unto the said Henry Penn a certain parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton and bounded by the lands of Joseph Cobb John Justice Robert Rankins and William Cook being the same lands the said W. H. H. Briggs purchase of Benjamin Griffin Esq^r of Joseph Vick dies containing by estimation one hundred and eight acres be the same more or less to have and to hold the aforesaid tract of land with all wood waters and appurtenances to the said land belonging or appertaining to him the said Henry Penn his heirs and assigns and in the said William H. Briggs and Sally his wife bind ourselves on them to warrant & forever defend the right and title of the aforesaid tract of land to him the said Henry Penn his heirs and assigns forever.
