This Indenture made this 2nd day of May in the year of our Lord 1826 Between Rich^d Pope and Elmina his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Burrnell Jones of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Witness that for and in consideration of twenty five dollars to them in hand paid by the said Burrnell Jones the receipt whereof they the said Rich^d Pope and Elmina his wife do hereby acknowledge have bargained and sold and by them presents do bargain and sell unto the said Burrnell Jones and his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid and bounded as follows Beginning at a large pine in the Reddy Branch a Corner in Benjamin Blunts and Richard R. Pope's line thence down the Reddy Branch to a large Rowan tree Branch in a new Corner for the said Rich^d Pope and Burrnell Jones thence up said branch a line of marked trees to a large Maple a Corner for the said Rich^d Pope and Burrnell Jones thence along the white oak Branch to a small black Gum a Corner between the said Richard R. Pope and Burrnell Jones thence along that line to the beginning containing by Estimation Five acres be the same more or less To have and to hold forever and our heirs and assigns forever the above granted premises with all & singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Burrnell Jones and his heirs & assigns forever and we further Covenant to and with the said Burrnell Jones that we will warrant and defend the right title and claim to the aforesaid tract of land against the Claim and demands of all and all manner of person in whatever claiming through or by us.
