This Indenture made the 6<sup>th</sup> day of October in the year 1825 between Eum Wiggins and Humfries his wife of the County of Hartford in the State of North Carolina of the one part and Joseph J. Holland of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia of the other part witnesseth that the said Eum Wiggins and Humfries his wife for and in consideration of the sum of no hundred dollars to them in hand paid by the said Joseph J. Holland at or before the concluding and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said Eum Wiggins and Humfries his wife have granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth each of them doth grant bargain sell unto the said Joseph J. Holland his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the upper parish of Chilhowie doth contain the aforesaid County of Southampton marked and bounded as follows Beginning at a small pine tree corner of James Steggs thence along Steggs line 160 & 130 poles to the main run of the Cypress Branch thence up the said branch the several courses of the run 297 poles to a S. 30 E. 100 feet from a corner on Echoe Barrens thence at N. 65 W. 210 poles to the beginning containing one hundred and forty six acres and so more or less the corners and boundaries remainder herein and other rents issues and profits thereof and every part thereof being thereof to have of & hold the said tract or parcel of land with the tenements hereditaments and all and singular other the premises & appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Joseph J. Holland his heirs & assigns forever and the said Eum Wiggins and Humfries his wife for themselves and their heirs the said tract or parcel of land with the premises and appurtenances unto the said Joseph J. Holland his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said Eum Wiggins & Humfries his wife or either them than or either of their heirs and of all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall well or l. do warrant and forever defend by these presents In witness whereof the said Eum Wiggins and Humfries his wife have hereunto set their hands and seals this day and year as first above written witness
