This Indenture made this twenty eighth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighteen between Robert P. Lockhead of the County of Southampton of the one part and William Jenkins of the same County of the other part. Whereas it is agreed between the said Robert P. Lockhead for himself and the said William Jenkins that the said Robert P. Lockhead for himself and the said William Jenkins shall receive and receive from the said Robert P. Lockhead the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Robert P. Lockhead hath bargained sold and by their presents do grant bargain sell unto the said William Jenkins one certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton containing by a late survey his bounded lately there are a half acre or being part of the tract purchased by the said Robert P. Lockhead of William J. Mom and bounded as follows: to wit beginning at the mouth of the Indian Branch on the Angelus Swamp thence up said swamp about 48 rods thirty poles to a cedar a corner in the land belonging to the said H. Morris. Same dead and standing in the old Mills hole there N. 56 East 100 poles thence N. 37 E. 100 poles thence N. 8 poles thence N. 37 E. 100 poles thence N. 39 W. 13 poles to a dead pine. Thence a corner in the said same line there N. 62 W. 16 poles thence S. 37 E. 111 1/2 poles thence S. 36 W. 8 poles thence S. 38 W. 12 poles thence S. 36 W. 20 poles thence S. 31 E. 111 1/2 poles thence S. 51 1/2 W. 3 poles to a dead pine a corner in the land of said H. Morris and Francis Reddy thence S. 34 E. 92 poles to a white oak standing on the south bank of the Angelus swamp thence along the aforesaid Reddy's line S. 55 E. East 235 poles to a white oak a corner in the said Reddy's line thence along a north line of marked trees north 4 1/2° west 16 1/2° poles to a maple thence N. 56 E. East 55 poles to a pine thence N. 31 1/2 E. 96 poles to a black gum standing in a hollow which leads into the spring branch thence N. 37 E. 66 poles to a pine thence N. 23 East 16 poles thence N. 30 E. 25 poles to a small gum a corner made in the rear of the aforesaid branch in Spratley Williams' line thence down the rear of the said Indian Branch to the beginning with all its appurtenances unto the said William Jenkins his heirs & assigns forever and the said Robert P. Lockhead for himself and his heirs to let to the aforesaid land and premises and every part thereof shall and will warrant defend and quiet title to the said William Jenkins his heirs and assigns forever and furthermore the said Robert P. Lockhead shall and will warrant and forever defend unto the said William Jenkins his heirs and assigns the title to the aforesaid land against all and every person who so far as William J. Mom did to him the said Robert P. Lockhead will indemnify for attorney's fees of the said Robert P. Lockhead hath executed set his hand and affixed his seal the day & year first above written
