This Indenture made this 31st day of May in the year 1826 Between Edward Crumpler & Joanna his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and George Camp jr of the said County of the other part and State of Virginia Metropolis that the said Edward Crumpler and Joanna his wife for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars to them in hand paid by the said George Camp jr at a before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said Edward Crumpler and Joanna his wife have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth grant bargain sell unto the said George Camp jr his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton at being part of the lot of land allotted to the said Crumpler in right of his wife the said Joanna in a division of the lands of which Samuel Foster did seize & possess of marked & bounded as follows: Beginning at a small Elm tree standing in the deep branch a corner of John Foster's line along his line to a corner pine in his line thence to a small red oak and thence thence the said Foster's line to a small black gum in Samuel Foster's line thence thence that runs to the great Island down the island to the deep Branch thence up the branch the various courses of the same to the first station containing forty five acres more less the various and various remain and remain on yearly and other rents upon the said land and every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land with the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said George Camp jr his heirs and assigns forever and the said Edward Crumpler and Joanna his wife for them do and thereunto the said tract or parcel of Land with the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said George Camp jr his heirs and assigns full from the claim or claim of them the said Edward Crumpler and Joanna his wife or either of them their or either of their heirs and of all and every other person or persons whatsoever they the said Edward Crumpler and Joanna his wife shall sell and do or attempt to do or defend by their presents In witness whereof the said Edward Crumpler & Joanna his wife have hereunto set their hands & seals the day and year as above written signed sealed & delivered in presence of
