This Indenture made the 10th day of November in the Year of our Lord 1822. Between William
Bryges of the first part John P. Slade of the second part and Henry Bryges of the third part
Whereas the said John P. Slade on the 3^d day of March in the year of our Lord 1822 in
order to secure the payment of the sum of one hundred twenty seven dollars & 87 cents the said Henry Bryges
did by Indenture of Trust of that date convey to the said William Bryges his heirs &c
a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by
Estimation sixty two acres and bounded as follows by the land of Richard Allen Thos
Spray and Littleberry. Inw upon Trust for the uses and purposes in the said Indenture
mentioned and whereas since the executing of the said deed of Trust the said John P. Slade
has fully satisfied and paid to the said Henry Bryges the sum of money thereby secured
whereby the said Henry Bryges doth hereby acknowledge. Now this Indenture witnesseth
that for the Consideration aforesaid as made as for the further Consideration of one dollar in
hand paid by the said John P. Slade to the said William Bryges at and before the execut-
ing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said
William Bryges with the assent and approbation of the said Henry Bryges signified
by his being party to these presents and the said Henry Bryges hath granted bargained
sold remised released and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain and sell remise
release & confirm unto the said John P. Slade all the estate right title interest claim
demand both at law and in equity which the said William Bryges & Henry Bryges
have or hold in the land above described To have and to hold the said tract or parcel
of land to the said John P. Slade his heirs &c forever or as long as he shall see fit to the use
proper use and behoof of him the said John P. Slade his heirs &c forever and the
said William Bryges and Henry Bryges for themselves their heirs &c and unto the
above mentioned the land unto the said John P. Slade his heirs &c forever or as long
in as full and ample manner as the same was warranted by the said John P.
Slade by the deed of Trust above recited as more at large to the said John P. Slade
against the claim or claims of them the said William Bryges & Henry Bryges
or all persons claiming by or under them or either of them In witness whereof the parties
to these presents have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day & year first above
