This Indenture made made this 20th day of July in the Year of our Lord 1826 Between William Blund of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Lewis Harris Jr trustee for the benefit of John Blund of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that whereas the said William Blund Jr has become indebted to the said John Blund in the Consideration of the sum of two hundred & sixteen dollars and to secure the payment thereof is willing and desirous to convey unto the said Lewis Harris Jr trustee the following property to wit a certain tract of Land Containing one hundred & twenty two acres also my Crop of Cotton now growing thereon negroes John Ench and Rachel To have and to hold the aforesaid and property unto the said Lewis Harris Jr his heirs and assigns and in special trust & consideration to the intent and purpose that if the aforesaid sum of two hundred & sixteen dollars shall remain unpaid to the said John Blund his heirs and assigns shall after giving legal notice expose the aforesaid property at Public Sale at any time after the 1st day of October next and with the money arising therefrom first to pay & satisfy the aforesaid sum of two hundred & sixteen dollars with interest & costs as also the expenses attending the execution of this trust and the surplus if any to return to me my heirs and assigns I do hereby certify that I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day & date before written signed sealed &c in presence of
