think proper to sell to the highest bidder for ready money at public auction after having fixed the  
time & place of sale at their own discretion and given twenty days notice thereof at least one month  
public places in the neighborhood previous to the day of sale and out of the monies arising from

and all other monies which may be due and owing from the said Nancy Bulls, Jeffs. Bulls, Fanny Bulls &  
Betty Bulls to the said John Clayton by means of any dealings transfer of debts or paper whatsoever  
as also for and consideration of one dollar to them in hand paid by the said Miley Williams the receipt  
whereof the Nancy Bulls, Jeffs. Bulls, Fanny Bulls and Betty Bulls doth hereby acknowledge hath granted  
bargained & sold and by these presents doth hereby grant bargains & sell convey and make over unto the said  
Miley Williams and his heirs forever all their right and interest in the following property to wit  
the tract of land wherein they now live containing by estimation one hundred & six acres situate  
in the same land whereof Henry Bulls and seized of property belonging to them the said  
Nancy Bulls, Jeffs. Bulls, Fanny. Bulls and Betty Bulls to have and to hold with
