May 1833.

This Indenture made this 24th day of July 1826 Between Albridgeon Sperry of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia of the one part and Henry Lenon of the same County and state aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the said Albridgeon Sperry for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said Henry Lenon the receipt whereof the said Albridgeon Sperry doth acknowledge gave grant bargain sell alien and Conferred unto Henry Lenon a certain tract or parcel of Land and plantations together with all the appurtenances belonging to the said plantation lying in the County aforesaid and bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at a black Jack tree growing James Lane from house straight line to a shrub oak formerly Polly Hogg's line from thence straight line to a white oak and from thence at Sept. Crocker and Joseph Lane's line from thence straight line to the front station containing by estimation one hundred & twenty five acres being the same more or less To have and to hold the aforesaid bargain and premises together with their and every of their appurtenances unto him the said Henry Lenon his heirs and assigns forever and the said Albridgeon Sperry doth hereby warrant the said tract of Land to be clear and free from all encumbrances whatsoever. This Indenture made this 19th day of November 1830 Between John F. Slade and wife Temperance of the one part and James Andrews all of the County of Southampton of the other part Witnesseth that the said John F. Slade and wife Temperance for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred & fifty dollars to them in hand paid by the said James Andrews the receipt whereof the said John F. Slade and wife Temperance doth hereby acknowledge they the said John F. Slade & wife Temperance have granted bargain and sold alien enfeof and Conferred and by their acts grant bargain and sell alien enfeof and Conferred unto the said James Andrews his heirs or assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing nearly two and one third acres be the same more or less and bounded by the lands of Richard P. Allen Thomas Gray Littleberry John Tolly Warren and Temperance Slade it being the land whereon the said John F. Slade now resides and also all trees wood underwood commons pastures profits. Commons duties advantages emoluments and hereditaments whatsoever to the said tract of Land above mentioned belonging or in anywise appertaining and also the reversion and reversioned term annuity or remainders rents or services of the premises and every part or parcel thereof and also all the estate right title interest claim demand whosoever of the said John F. Slade and wife Temperance in and to the said premises and every part thereof To have and to hold all and singular the said premises above mentioned with every part and parcel thereof with its appurtenances unto the said James Andrews his heirs &c. to the only proper use and behoof of the said James Andrews his heirs &c. forever and the said John F. Slade and wife Temperance for them & their heirs the said Tract of Land and every part thereof against themselves and their heirs & against all and every person whatsoever to the said James Andrews his heirs and assigns shall & will warrant and forever defend by their persons or Attorneys whereof the said John F. Slade and wife Temperance hath hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day & Year first written
