This Indenture made this the 33<sup>rd</sup> day of March in the Year of our Lord 1826 Between John C  
Turner and Nancy his wife of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia and in  
the lower district of Saint Luke parish of the first part and Nancy and Sally Vick copart  
of Samuel Vick of the other part witness that the said John C Turner and Nancy his  
wife for and consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty eight dollars to them in hand  
paid by the said Nancy and Sally Vick on or before the recording and delivery of this present  
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents  
doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Nancy and Sally Vick their heirs and  
assigns forever one certain one acre tract or parcel of land lying and being in the  
County and Parish aforesaid containing by late survey thirty two acres to the same  
more or less as being the lot or parcel of land lying set aside for Evans Jackson purchased  
by said John C Turner of Jordan Jackson and Micajah Jackson as one of their shares of their  
partners land and set aside by Commissioners for the heirs of said Evans Jackson and divided as  
follows Beginning at a lightning Lump standing in a little Branch and on the south side of  
the Byprep Road thence a little west of South the various Courses of said road to a small old  
oak standing on the north side of said road thence nearly west by South East line  
nearly west to a small pine a corner of said land and said tract on said Branch  
line thence nearly north by the said Branch line to a Turkey oak a corner  
of said road to a point on said line thence by the said Jackson line the said  
line then to Stephen Barrett's line thence by the said Barrett's line nearly  
west to a small sapling on said Branch line a corner of said tract & Return  
hence a little west of North to the said Wharf field line to a pine thence to  
a black Gum on the river of the same branch as the beginning from thence
