This Indenture made this the 22nd day of March in the Year of our Lord 1826 Between John C
Turner and Nancy his wife of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia and in
the lower district of Saint Lukes parish of the first part and Nancy and Sally Vick of the second
part of Samuel Vick of the other part Witnesseth that the said John C. Turner and Nancy his
wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty eight dollars to them in hand
paid by the said Nancy and Sally Vick on or before the executing and attesting of these presents
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents
doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Nancy and Sally Vick their heirs and
assigns forever one certain messuage tract or parcel of land lying and being in the
County and Parish aforesaid Containing by late Survey thirty two acres be the same
more or less at being the lot or parcel of land being set aside for Isaac Withers purchase
by said Isaac of Jordan Jackson and Micajah Jackson as one of their shares of their
husband and set aside by Compromise for the heirs of said Isaac Withers and divided as
follows Beginning at a lightwood stump standing in a little Branch and on the south side of
the highway Road thence a little west of South the narrow corner of said road to a small red
oak standing on the north side of said road thence nearly west by Sarah Fick's line
nearly west to a small pine a corner of said land and said Vick on one corner
of said then S. Sally Jackson on said land thence to a Turkey oak a corner
thence to Stephen Barnett's line thence by the said Barnett's line nearly
west thence a little west of South to the said Withers field line to a pine thence
black gum in the run of the same corner in the beginning from (changed)
