J. Peete in Land by the said William Princes paid or secured to be paid to the said
Alexander J. Peete hath given granted bargained sold and conveyed and do by these presents
give grant bargain sell and convey to the said William Princes his heirs &c the following
pieces parcels or tract of land to wit one Lot of land containing by survey seventy acres
known by Lot No. 1 which was drawn by the John Princes in the division of his father
John Princes est. which said Lot No. 1 was sold and conveyed by the said John
