Feby. 1819 between Lemuel Whitchard of Southampton County and State of Virginia of the one part and Clements Rockelle of the same County and State of the other part witnesseth that the said Lemuel Whitchard in consideration of four hundred pounds lawful money of the Commonwealth to him in hand paid by the said Clements Rockelle at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain & sell unto the said Clem. Rockelle his heirs and assigns all my right title interest claim profits advantages &c. that is due to me from my Father and mother's estate John Whitchard and Menan Whitchard or ever shall be due one when ever the said estate shall be finally settled both real and personal estate whatsoever to the said Clem. Rockelle. To have and to hold the said property herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights members and appurtenances unto the said Clem. Rockelle his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use of him the said Clem. Rockelle his heirs &c. forever and the said Lemuel Whitchard for himself his heirs &c. forever warrant & defend unto the said Clem. Rockelle the right and title before mentioned unto the said Clem. Rockelle his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of him the said Lemuel Whitchard his heirs and of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall will and do against and forever defend by these presents. Pope and Elmina his wife for and in consideration of the sum of twenty three dollars to them in hand paid by the said Bunwell Jones at and before the executing and delivery hereof the receipt whereof the said Richard P. Pope and his wife doth hereby acknowledge and thereof doth acquit the said Bunwell Jones his heirs and assigns have bargained sold aliened Confirmed and make over to the said Bunwell Jones his heirs & assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton Virginia and bounded by the following land to wit Beginning at a pointed corner thence along the said line to a red oak a corner thence along Bonanzaum Plank line to a pine a new corner in said line thence along a new marked line to the beginning Containing five and a half acres be the same more or less To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land and all the singular the improvements thereto belonging to him the said Bunwell Jones his heirs and assigns forever to his proper use and behoof of the said Bunwell Jones to him his heirs and assigns and to no other use intent or meaning whatsoever and the Richard Pope and his wife doth for themselves their heirs assigns Covenant grant & agree to and with the said Bunwell Jones his heirs & assigns against all persons claims of whatsoever kind &c. witness whereof the said Richard P. Pope and Elmina have hereunto set their hands & affixed their seals the day & date above written
