This Indenture made this 21<sup>st</sup> day of August 1826 between John Drake of the one part and Edwin Beal of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part. That the said John Drake for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars to him or him paid by the said Edwin Beal before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said John Drake do hereby acknowledge and thereof and therefrom acquit discharge the said Edwin Beal and thereupon hath granted bargained sold & delivered and by these presents do bargain sell alien enfeoff and Confirm unto the said Edwin Beal his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract of land which the said John Drake purchased from his brother Samuel Drake and Eliza a Nancy E. Mary & Mary H Drake by deed containing only four acres which deed was duly recorded in the Clerk's office of this County on the 21<sup>st</sup> March 1826 reference being thereto has the boundaries whereof were fully appraised to have and to hold the said land and premises with all and every the emoluments profits rents issues tenements and hereditaments unto the said Edwin Beal his heirs & assigns forever the said John Drake do make over & Confirm unto the said Edwin Beal his heirs & assigns forever To have and to hold the same with all its appurtenances to the said Edwin Beal his heirs and assigns forever and the said John Drake defend the right & title of the said land against himself his heirs and assigns forever and all and every person or persons whomsoever claiming or that may lawfully the same or any part thereof unto the said Edwin Beal his heirs and assigns forever that it will warrant and defend by these presents sealed with my seal & dated this 21<sup>st</sup> day and date above written signed sealed & delivered in presence of
