This Indenture the 21st day of August in the Year of our Lord 1826 between Enight Jonathan Washington of the County of Halifax and State of North Carolina of the one part and John Williamson of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part Witnesseth that the said Jonathan Washington for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty dollars and fifty Cents of lawful money of Virginia to him the said Jonathan Washington in hand paid well and truly paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Jonathan Washington hath granted bargained sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said John Williamson his heirs and assigns one certain tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and twenty six acres be the same more or less lying in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and bounded by the lands of Walter W. Smith Winifred White George Branch Lewis Branch &c also all the estate right title interest Claims and demands whosoever of him the said Jonathan Washington of in and to the said Land and every part thereof to have and to hold the said Land and every part and parcel thereof unto the said John Williamson his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of
