This Indenture made this 26th day of April in the Year of our Lord Christ 1826 Between Elizabeth Turner of Southampton County of the one part and Eum Turner of the County aforesaid of the other part witnesses that the said Elizabeth Turner for and in consideration of the just and full sum of one hundred dollars Current money of Virginia by the said Eum Turner to her in hand paid at or before the executing of delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Elizabeth Turner doth hereby acknowledge herself fully and amply satisfied and paid. The said Elizabeth Turner have granted bargained sold aliened set over and delivered and by these presents do grant bargain sell set over and deliver release and Confirm unto the said Eum Turner his heirs assigns forever all that plantation messuage tract or parcel of land situate lying & being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Netteray containing by Estimation Eighty seven acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows To wit Beginning at a Spruce tree in John Turners line thence along said Turners line to a red oak in Samuel Turners line thence along said Turners line to a small pine a Corner tree in a line formerly Nelson Wades thence along said Wades line to a black gum standing in a small branch in a line formerly Richard Worrells line thence along the Worrells line to a post oak a Corner tree in Samuel Turners line thence along said Turners line to a red oak a Corner tree in said Turners line thence along said Turners line to the beginning together with all houses out houses edifices buildings Vard. Gardens orchard her way waters and water Courses profits Commodities and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise appurtenant and the reversion and reversions remainder and remainders with issue and profits thereof and all the estate right title interest Claim and demand of the said Elizabeth Turner of us and to the same and any part thereof To have and to hold the said tract messuage or parcel of land unto him the said Eum Turner his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Eum Turner his heirs assigns forever and the said Elizabeth Turner and her heirs and assigns the said Eighty seven acres more or less with the appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise appurtenant unto him the said Eum Turner his heirs and assigns forever against the said Elizabeth Turner and her heirs and assigns and against all persons whatsoever Claiming or demanding the same or any part thereof Shall and will warrant & forever defend by these presents.
