This Indenture made this 15th day of September in the Year of our Lord Christ 1826 between James Jones and Leahy his wife both of the County of Gates and State of North Carolina of the one part and Benjamin Morrell of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part witnesseth that the said James Jones and Leahy his wife for and in consideration of the sum of seventy eight dollars and seventy five Cents to them in hand paid by the said Benjamin Morrell the receipt whereof the said James Jones and Leahy his wife doth hereby acknowledge themselves fully and amply satisfied and paid hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed & confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell unto the said Benjamin Morrell to him and to his heirs forever all their right title interest in all the lands of Samuel Woodward Jr decd which land is situated lying & being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia aforesaid containing by estimation one hundred acres more or less and bounded by Westa Popes line John Dags heirs line and others it being the land & plantation wherein Samuel Woodward Sr lived and died and was bequeathed by him to his son Samuel Woodward Jr together with all Houses out houses Edifiers buildings Yards gardens orchards ways waters and water Courses whatsoever belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said right title interest Claim of them the said James Jones and Leahy his wife To have and to hold the same unto the said Benjamin Morrell to him & his heirs forever and the said James Jones and Leahy his wife for themselves their heirs executors administrators and assigns do by these presents warrant and forever defend all their right title and interest in said land unto the said Benjamin Morrell his heirs and assigns against the Claim or demand of any other person or persons claiming or demanding the same In witness whereof the said James Jones and Leahy his wife hath hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals this day and date above written signs sealed & del^d
