This Indenture made this 24th day of August 1826 between James Powell Jr and Sally his wife of the County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Luke of the one part and Elizabeth Harris of the other part Witnesseth that the said James Powell Jr and Sally his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Elizabeth Harris doth hereby acknowledge themselves fully and amply satisfied and hath granted bargained sold and delivered and confirmed and by these presents doth bargain sell deliver unto the said Elizabeth Harris her heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying & being in the County of Southampton and parish aforesaid containing by estimation one hundred and fifty eight acres be the same more or less Beginning at a dead oak stump a corner made between James Powell and Salathiel Francis standing on the side of Henry Turners old Mill Pond thence down the mill Pond to a corner in James Powells line and thence along a line of marked trees to the branch called the Toll branch thence up the Toll branch various courses to a street gain a new corner made between James Powell and Salathiel Francis thence along a new line of marked trees from thence to the beginning. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land and premises unto the said Elizabeth Harris to her and her heirs forever and the said James Powell & Sally his wife do for them selves their heirs and assigns forever warrant and defend the just right and title of any person or persons whatsoever unto the said Elizabeth Harris.
