This Indenture made and done this 2^d day of August 1826 between Jesse Furgason and Lucy his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Levi Furgason of the County and State aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Jesse Furgason and Lucy his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and eleven dollars to them in hand paid by the said Levi Furgason before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge and thereof and therefrom acquit and discharge the said Levi Furgason and thereupon have bargained sold and delivered and by these presents doth bargain sell alien enfeoff & Confirm unto the said Levi Furgason his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land containing $\frac{3}{4}$ of the land or parcel whereof John Furgason died seized and possessed of containing seventy eight acres more or less with all and every the Emoluments and profits rents services offices Tenements and hereditaments unto the said Levi Furgason his heirs and assigns forever the said Jesse Furgason and Lucy his wife do hereby make over and Confirm to the said Levi Furgason To have and to hold the same with all its appurtenances to the said Levi Furgason his heirs and assigns forever and the said Jesse Furgason and Lucy his wife the said Land and premises against themselves and their heirs and all and every other person or persons whatsoever claiming or may lawfully claim any part or parcel thereof unto the said Levi Furgason his heirs and assigns forever shall and will warrant & forever defend by these presents sealed with our seals and dated the day & date above written
