This Indenture made this 19th of September in the Year 1826 between Henry T Magst
Robert Goodman and Austin Middleton all of the County of Southampton witnesseth that whereas
the said Henry T Magst stands justly indebted to the said Robert Goodman by a certain sum
obligatory under his seal and bearing date equal with these presents for the sum of one hundred
and seventy two dollars 70 cents on demand the 20th September 1826 and whereas the said Henry
T Magst is willing and desirous to secure and indemnify the said Robert Goodman it is
agreed by the said Henry and Robert Goodman that a Conveyance in trust shall be made to
the said Austin Middleton in case the said bond shall not be paid when demanded & for
this indenture therefore witnesseth that the said Henry T Magst for and in consideration of
the sum of one dollar to him欠人 paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath
granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell make over &
Confer unto the said Austin Middleton and his heirs and assigns a certain tract
part of land containing forty-one acres adjoining the land of Charles Magst & Priscilla
Magst in the County aforesaid to have and to hold the said tract of Land as also the
undivided interest which he had in the demesne land of mother the said Priscilla Magst
to the said Austin Middleton his heirs and assigns without necessity and upon this
express condition that of the said Henry T Magst his heirs or assigns shall principally
pay to the said Robert Goodman his heirs and assigns the aforesaid sum of one hundred &
seventy two dollars and seventy two cents agreeable to the value of the land aforesaid when
the said Middleton shall execute proper and legal release for the property hereby
conveyed is agreed by the parties to these presents that in case the said Henry T Magst his heirs
or assigns shall fail to make payment of the debt when above sequin then the said Austin
Middleton his heirs or assigns shall at the request of the said Robert Goodman his heirs or
assigns at any time after giving due notice not less than ten days shall publickly sale the aforesaid
tract of land and the interest or right in the said demesne land and shall pay the money arising
from the said sale to the said Robert Goodman his heirs and assigns and shall pay the surplus
money if any to the said Henry T Magst his heirs or assigns In witness whereof the parties
have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year above written written
