This Indenture made the 17th day of September in the year 1826 Between Joseph J. Holland and Letitia his wife of the one part and Jeremiah Gardner his husband both of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia witnesseth that the said Joseph J. Holland and Letitia his wife for and consideration of the sum of two hundred and thirty three dollars to them欠人未付 paid by the said Jeremiah Gardner at or before the execution and delivery of these presents they the said Joseph J. Holland and Letitia his wife have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Jeremiah Gardner his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying & being in the aforesaid County of Southampton marked and bounded as following Beginning at a small fence a corner of James Scoggins thence along his line South 65° E 125 poles to a gum at the run of the Cypress Swamp thence up said swamp the several Courses of the run and boundaries theron 257 poles to a small stream known as a Creek in Eliza Wardens thence S 58 W 76 poles to a large Rosemary tree said boundary and Henry Bradens Creek thence S 63 W 76 poles to a gum thence S 66 W 58 poles to the beginning containing one hundred & thirty six acres and one rod more or less the reversion and issues & remainders and remainders yearly and other rents issues and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with the tenements, hereditaments and all & singular the franchises and appurtenances before mentioned or intended to be bargained & sold with every of their rights member and appurtenances unto the said Jeremiah Gardner his husband assign forever and the said Joseph J. Holland and Letitia his wife for themselves and their heirs the said tract or parcel of Land with the franchises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Jeremiah Gardner his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said Joseph J. Holland and Letitia his wife or either of them their or either of their heirs & of all and every other person or persons whatsoever they the said Joseph J. Holland and Letitia his wife shall will and do warrant and forever defend by these presents In witness whereof the said Joseph J.
