

This Indenture made and executed the 27th day of September in the Year of our Lord 1826 between Everett & Maget of the one part and John Hargrave of the other part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witnesses that whereas the said John Hargrave by his and in trust bearing date the 9th day of December 1820 did convey to the said Everett & Maget in trust for the benefit of John Parrott a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County aforesaid containing two hundred acres be the same more or less and adjoining the lands of Henry Bishop William Allen John Harris Manney Maget and the heirs of Samuel Maget dec'd to secure a debt of Three hundred and twelve dollars which appears by bond bearing equal date with this deed in trust aforesaid executed and made payable to the said John Parrott and by him transferred to Elisha Butler and the said debt with the accruing interest thereon being fully paid and satisfied by the said John Hargrave his then Indenture further in witness that for and in consideration of the circumstances aforesaid as well for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar by the said John Hargrave to me in hand paid. I the said John Hargrave as Trustee aforesaid do hereby release make over & convey unto the said John Hargrave the aforesaid tract or parcel of land lying & being in the County aforesaid and adjoining the lands of the said Henry Bishop William Allen John Harris Manney Maget and the heirs of Samuel Maget dec'd together with the appurtenances therunto belonging To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land with all appurtenances to the said John Hargrave his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said John Hargrave his heirs and assigns forever So that the said Everett & Maget John Parrott and Elisha Butler nor either of them nor either of their heirs nor any other persons whatsoever claiming under them or either of them shall by any ways or means hereafter have claim challenge or demand any estate right title or interest of in or to the said premises or any part thereof nor to the said premises or any part thereof but from all and every action for the recovery thereof and from all and every estate right title interest or demand of in or to the said premises or any part thereof they and every of them shall be utterly excluded (have) forever by these presents In Witness whereof the parties of the first part & trustee aforesaid hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his Seal the day and Year first herein written Signed Sealed & Delivered
