Blount in his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land containing twenty five acres beginning on Days line where it crosses Crossford Road up the said Road to the sign post at the Cross Keys thence up the said Road to a new post in the said Road thence to days line so far as to include twenty five acres thence along Days line to the beginning containing twenty five acres Land to have and to hold the said twenty five acres Land with all and singular the appurtenances thereto
