and assigns forever upon this special Trust nevertheless that the said Davy Gay upon being thereof required
by the aforesaid Orson Branch shall proceed to sell all the right and interest of the said Orson Branch
to the abovesigned negroes hereby Conveyed or intended to be conveyed after advertising the time and
place in the said County of Southampton for ten days previous at some publick house or store for
cash and out of the money arising out or from the said sale in the first place pay & satisfy as well
the expenses attending the said Conveyance and then pay off the debts aforesaid with interest
as well as all other monies which may appear to be due and owing from the said Orson Branch
to the said Davy Davis by means of any dealings Transfer of debts or paper whatever and the
surplus if any to the said Orson Branch and the said Davy Gay for himself his heirs executors
and administrators the right and title of the said Orson Branch unto the said Davy Gay his heirs and
assigns forever doth hereby warrant and forever defend against the lawful claim or claims
of him the said Orson Branch his heirs executors and against all and every other person
or persons whomsoever and the said Davy Gay on his part Covenants and agrees that he will
make sale of the rights and interest hereby Conveyed for the best price he can obtain for the
same after advertising the time and place for ten days previous at some publick house
or store in the said County and with the monies arising from the sale first pay and
satisfy all cost attending the same as well as the expenses attending this Conveyance and
then pay off the aforesaid debts and interest as well as all other monies which may appear

Gay of said County the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars current money of Virginia and being
desirous and willing to secure the payment thereof have agreed for the aforesaid sum of one hundred
and fifty dollars as also one dollar to me in hand paid by Geo Gay the sum whereof is hereby
acknowledged I the said John Shepherd have granted bargained and sold and by these presents
to grant bargains sell unto the said George Gay the following property to wit one Tract of
Land which I bought of said John Gay containing by late survey thirty six and half acres
to have the aforesaid Land unto the said Geo. Gay his heirs and assigns and in trust
Trust and Consideration to the intent and purpose that of the aforesaid sum of one
hundred and fifty dollars shall remain unpaid to the said John Gay his heirs
