This Indenture made this 31st day of October in the year of our Lord Christ 1826 Between
Samuel Champion and Elizabeth his wife of the County of Sussex and State of Virginia of the one
part and Herbert Holt of the County and State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the said
Samuel Champion and Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one
thousand dollars good and lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the
said Herbert Holt (or secured to be paid) the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge
have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do freely grant bargains sell
alien enfull release and confirm unto the said Herbert Holt his heirs exec &
admit and assign forever one certain tract or parcel of Land situated lying & being in the
County of Southampton and bounded as follows Beginning at a black Gum in the west
prong of the Hamet Swamp a corner tree for said Land and on Richard Clements line
where the Scuffield Branch intersects with the Hamet Swamp thence up the said Scuffield
Branch by the said Clements line of marked trees in the run of said Branch to a
small Sassafras a corner for said Land and Clements thence by a line of mark³ trees
a pr^{small} branch south prong of said Scuffield Branch to a tree and aft. Thus on the East of
said Branch by the said Clements line to a small prue a corner for Isaac Kendall
and said land on the head of Railleys Run Branch thence down the various course
of the runs of said Branch dividing between said Kendall to a large Cypress in the
run of the South Spring of the Hamet Swamp a corner for said Land & land Kendall
thence down the run as it meanders to where the north Spring intersects with the South
Spring near Kettisons mill thence up the said north Spring of said Swamp to the
beginning a black Gum containing by estimation two hundred and twenty one half
acres to the same more or less with all the right profit claim or interest thereunto how
the said Herbert Holt his heirs exec and assign forever and the said Samuel Champion
and Elizabeth his wife themselves their heirs exec and assign doth covenant
to and with the said Herbert Holt his heirs exec and assign forever that they said
Land is free and clear of all incumbrances whatsoever and that they have full
right good power and lawful authority to grant sell and convey the same freely
warranting and forever defending the legal title thereto to the said Herbert Holt
in their exec and assign not only against themselves their heirs exec and
against all and every other person whatsoever. In witness whereof they the said
