This Indenture made this 18th day of December in the year of our Lord 1826
Between Stewart Edwards of the one part and George G. Gurley of the other part both
of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Writeth that for and in con-
sideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said
George G. Gurley, at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged by him the said Stewart Edwards, Have bargained &
sold and by these presents do hereby bargain & sell unto him the said George G. Gurley
his heirs and assigns one certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the
County aforesaid and lower district of Saint Lukes parish containing forty acres
be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit. Beginning at a small bay
in a branch a corner in the line between the said Edwards and Elizabeth. Beate
thence down the various courses of said branch to a dead black Gum stump a
corner in the line between the said Edwards and the heirs of Richard. Floor died
thence by a line of marked trees to a small white oak a corner between the said
heirs and the said Edwards from thence a straight line to the road thence up the S^d
Road to a small red oak stump a corner in Elizabeth. Beate line thence by a line of
marked trees to the beginning. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land with
the improvements hereunto and all singular other the premises here before mentioned
or intended to be bargained & sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their
rights members and appurtenances unto the said George G. Gurley his heirs & assigns
forever and to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said George G. Gurley
his heirs and assigns forever and the said Stewart Edwards for himself this heirs the
said Tract of Land with all singular the premises and appurtenances before men-
tioned unto the said George G. Gurley his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claim
of him the said Stewart Edwards his heirs and of all and every person or persons whatsoever
shall and will forever warrant & defend by these presents In witness whereof the said Stewart
Edwards have hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the 18th day of December 1826

Whitney doth acknowledge. Now granted bargained & sold and by these presents do
grant bargain and sell to the said Jesse Lankford his heirs & assigns the
following property to wit two bed and furniture two water tubs three Lard
trunks
