This Indenture made this 3^d day of January in the year of our Lord 1827. Between John Carrall, Richard B. Kells and Orson Branch Commissioners appointed by the County Court of Southampton of the one part and Alfred B. Bottle of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Carrall, Richard B. Kells and Orson Branch for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and seventy six dollars, lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Alfred S. Bottle at or before the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. Have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said Alfred S. Bottle his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by a late survey seventy five acres and bounded as follows to wit on the north east by Benjamin B. Flowers land on the east by Isaac Whites land. To wit on the South East by Gravelly M. B. Bottle's land and on the South west by Alfred S. Bottle's line to the beginning at being the land that fell to John A. Bottle as his proportionable part of said Father's Estate John Bottle died, together with all the hereditaments & appurtenances whatsoever to the said Land belonging or appertaining with the reversion & reversion remainders and remainders issues and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said Land with the tenements hereditaments and all & singular other the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained & sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights members and appurtenances unto the said Alfred S. Bottle his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use and behoof of the said Alfred S. Bottle and the said John Carrall, Richard B. Kells and Orson Branch Commissioners as aforesaid for themselves and their heirs the said Land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Alfred S. Bottle his heirs & assigns freed from the claims or claims of them the said John Carrall, Richard B. Kells and Orson Branch Commissioners or either of them their or either of their heirs & assigns and do warrant and forever defend all the right and title as vested in them as Commissioners aforesaid In witness whereof the said John Carrall, Richard B.
