This Indenture made this 20th day of May in the year of our Lord 1822 between Jeph^e
B. Washington of the first part James P. Morgan of the second part and John Morgan of
the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Witnesseth that
she has Jeph^e B. Washington for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred & twenty
seven dollars & 78/100 which said sum is due from the said Jeph^e B. Washington to the
said John Morgan by his bearing date the 20th day of May 1822 as well as all other
monies which may be due and owing from the said Jeph^e B. Washington to the said
John Morgan by means of any dealings transfer of debts or paper whatever as also for
and in consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said James P. Morgan
the receipt whereof the said Jeph^e B. Washington doth hereby acknowledge hath granted
bargained and sold and by these presents doth hereby grant bargain and sell convey &
make over unto the said James P. Morgan and his heirs forever all his right & interest
in the following property to wit one certain tract or parcel of Land wherein the said Jeph^e
B. Washington now resides containing by estimation Sixty five acres to the same more
or less and being the entire tract and all the lands which the said Jeph^e B. Washington
now also negro Angelina two Beds and furniture two Chorses ten head of Hogs two
Cows and all the Chattell Estate of every kind whatsoever as well as his present Crop now
growing belonging to him the said Jeph^e B. Washington to have and to hold with all &
singular the right and interest of the said Jeph^e B. Washington herein Conveyed or intended
to be Conveyed to him the said James P. Morgan his heirs and assigns forever upon this
special but nevertheless that the said James P. Morgan upon being thereto required
by the said John Morgan shall proceed to sell all the right and interest of the said
Jeph^e B. Washington to the above named property to wit Land negro Stock Horses & Chattell
Estate hereby Conveyed or intended to be Conveyed after advertising the time and place
in the said County of Southampton for ten days previous at some publick House or Store
for Cash and out of the money arising out of or from the said sale in the first place pay &
satisfy all costs attending the said sale as well the expense attending the said Conveyance
and then pay off the Bond aforesaid with interest as well as all other monies which may
appear to be due and owing from the said Jeph^e B. Washington to the said James P. Morgan
by means of any dealings hauing of debts or paper whatever and the surplus if any pay
to the said Jeph^e B. Washington and the said Jeph^e B. Washington for himself his heirs
Executors and adm^rs the right and title of the said property herein Conveyed unto the said James
P. Morgan his heirs and assigns forever doth hereby warrant and defend against the lawfull
claim of him the said Jeph^e B. Washington his heirs Executors & Administrators
and against all and every other person or persons whom ever and the said James P. Morgan on
his part Covenants and agrees that he will make sale of the right and interest hereby Conveyed
for the best price he can obtain for the same after advertising the time and place for ten days
previous at some publick House or Store in the said County and with the monies from the sale first
pay and satisfy all costs attending this Conveyance and then pay off the aforesaid Bond interest
as well as all other monies which may appear to be due and owing from the said James P. Morgan
to the said Jeph^e B. Washington by means of any dealings Transfer of paper
