said Edwin Beale hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant
bargain & sell unto the said Edwin Beale his heirs and assigns one tract or
parcel of Land situate and being in the County of Southampton by State
of Virginia Containing sixty three acres siting the same Land which said
John Drake drew from his father's estate which was laid off and
divided by Commissioners (reference to their report which was filed in the
Clerk's office the boundaries &c. will fully appear to hold the said Land Tenure
hereditaments with all and singular the premises herein before mentioned or to be
to be bargained & sold with every of their rights members and appurtenances unto him
the said Edwin Beale his heirs and assigns forever and the said John Drake for
himself and his heirs the said Land with the premises and appurtenances unto the
said Edwin Beale his heirs and assigns forever free from the Claim or Claims of him the
said John Drake or either of his heirs or assigns and every person whatsoever Shall
and by these presents defend In witness whereof the said John Drake do. Sign seal
