This Indenture made this 3<sup>d</sup> day of February 1827 Between Bela H. Fitch of the County of Southampton of the first part & Wm S. Powers and A. McClelland of the Town of Petersburg of the second part and James Rochelle of the third part witnesseth that whereas the said Bela H. Fitch stand justly indebted unto the said Wm S. Powers in the sum and full sum of Three hundred and fourteen dollars and Twenty Cents due by him specially bearing date the 6<sup>th</sup> day of May 1826 and made payable the ninth month ensuing after date and whereas the said Bela H. Fitch stands justly indebted to the said A. McClelland in the sum of twenty seven dollars & thirty two Cents due by account both which said debts are now the property of the said Wm S. Powers and the said Bela H. Fitch being willing and desirous effectually to secure to the said William S. Powers the payment of the aforesaid debts and all interest that may accrue thereon to the intent and purpose that the said Bela H. Fitch as well for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid as for the further consideration of one dollar to him the said Bela H. Fitch in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and by these presents doth grant bargain & sell unto the said James Rochelle his exec or admi all his the said Bela H. Fitch's stock of goods now or hand all the debts now due on the books of said Bela H. Fitch all his house hold & kitchen furniture stock of all kinds and all the said Fitch's negro Slaves which he derived title to by intermarriage with his wife late James which have been or may be allotted to him by common p'mis to divide the slaves belonging to the estate or heirs of Robert James dead all which said property has been carried by the said in Trust and to secure a debt due to Levi Joy to which Henry Quiley is security and also to secure an unsettled account between the estate of Henry Quiley dead and said Bela H. Fitch or the other to secure a debt due to Levi Joy to have and to hold the aforesaid property and every part & parcel thereof unto him the said James Rochelle his exec or admi shall at any time at the request of the said William H. Powers make sale of the aforesaid property after first giving ten days notice of the time and place of sale on such credit as to the said James Rochelle shall think most advisable and out of the proceeds of such sale pay and satisfy the above debts interest & costs to the said William H. Powers and the surplus of any pay over to the said Bela H. Fitch and it is understood and agreed by and between the parties to these presents that if a sale of the aforesaid property or any part thereof should take place on either of the aforesaid days in Trust executed by the said Bela H. Fitch that any surplus of such sale after paying the debt or debts specified in said deed or deed in Trust shall be subject to the payment of the aforesaid debts due to the said Wm S. Powers as aforesaid and the said Bela H. Fitch retaining if his exec or admi with forever manant and defend the right & title to the aforesaid property and every part and parcel thereof against himself his heirs exec. and admi and against all and every person or persons whomsoever.
