doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained sold aliened and Conferred unto the
said Lemuel Harris his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land
Containing two hundred and thirty eight acres and bounded by the Land of Lewis
Harris William a few feet and the Land of John Whitehead dead Containing two
hundred & thirty eight acres land more or less. To have and to hold the said two hundred &
thirty eight acres land with all and singular the appurtenances therunto belonging
unto the said Lemuel Harris his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use &
behalf of him the said Lemuel Harris his heirs and assigns forever and the said
Thomas E. Holladay and Nancy his wife doth for themselves their heirs & assigns
agree unto the said Lemuel Harris his heirs and assigns that the said Thomas E.
Holladay and Nancy his wife their heirs & assigns shall & lawfully warrant &
forever defend the above mentioned land and premises unto the said Lemuel Harris
his heirs and assigns forever against the Claims or title of all person or persons what-
