Holladay and Stancy his wife for and consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars to them on hand paid or before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof we the said Thomas E. Holladay and Stancy his wife doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained & sold aliened and confirmed unto the said Austin Harris his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land containing two hundred and thirty eight acres and bounded by the Land of Mrs. Harris William Terrell and the Land of John Whitehead deed containing two hundred & thirty eight acres land more or less to have and to hold the said two hundred & thirty eight acres land with all and singular the appurtenances therunto belonging unto the said Austin Harris his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use & behoof of him the said Austin Harris his heirs and assigns forever and the said Thomas E. Holladay and Stancy his wife doth furthermore their heirs covenant & agree to the said Austin Harris his heirs and assigns that the said Thomas E. Holladay and Stancy his wife their heirs heirs and assigns shall & will warrant & forever defend the above mentioned land and premises unto the said Austin Harris his heirs and assigns forever against the claim or title of all person or persons whatsoever.
